What is an epistle? What are the Epistles in the Bible? The Epistles of the Bible are all found in the New Testament. They include 21 of the New Testamentâ€™s 27 books, extending from Romans to Jude. Thirteen of these Epistles were written by the apostle Paul: Romans, 1 and 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 and 2 Thessalonians, 1 and 2 Timothy, Titus, and Philemon.
